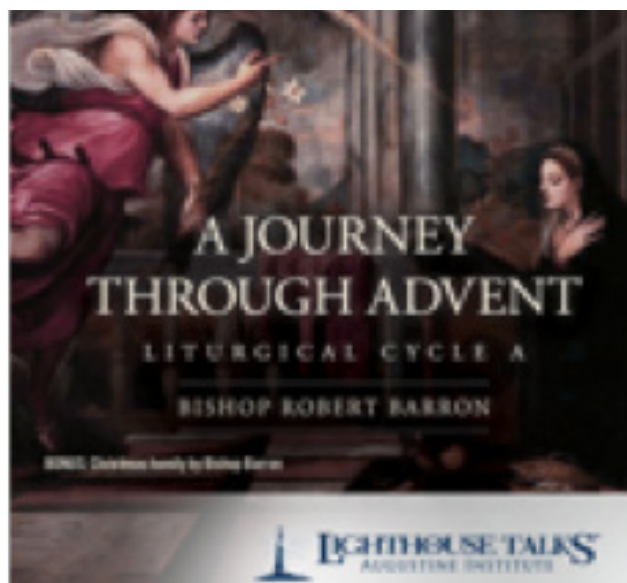
Catholic Lighthouse Media: Advent Is Almost Here!

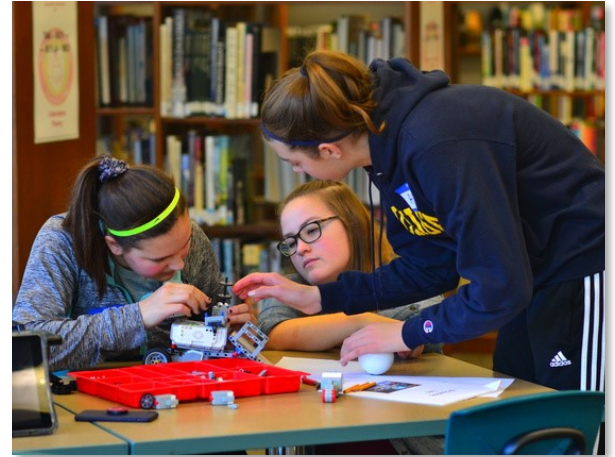
