Please note these changes and how they may affect your family's transportation schedule.





Health Tips for Parents From the School Office

Many parents ask, "When is my child sick enough to stay home from school?" This is not always an easy question to answer! We hope these tips can help!

A child who is sick will not be able to perform well in school and is likely to spread the illness to other children and staff. We suggest making a plan for childcare ahead of time so you will not be caught without a comforting place for your child to stay if he/she is ill.

If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school and provide the reason. Please let the office know the specific symptoms your child is experiencing and any official medical diagnosis your child has received.

Our school policy states that you should not send your child to school if he/she has:

- Fever in the past 24 hours
- Vomiting in the past 24 hours
- Diarrhea in the past 24 hours
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Strep Throat (must have been taking an antibiotic for at least 24 hours before returning to school)
- Bad cold, with a very runny nose or bad cough, especially if it has kept the child awake at night
- Head lice--until your child has been treated according to the doctor's or professional's instructions

If your child becomes ill at school and the office staff feels your child is too sick to benefit from school or is contagious to other children, you will be called to come and take him/her home from school. It is essential that the office staff has a phone number where you can be contacted during the day and an emergency number in the event you cannot be reached. Please be sure that arrangements can be made to transport your child home from school and that childcare is available in case of illness.

If your daytime or emergency phone number changes during the year, please notify the office at 734-451-2490. These guidelines are meant to serve the best interests of all the children and staff in school. If you have questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to call.



Classroom Happenings


