

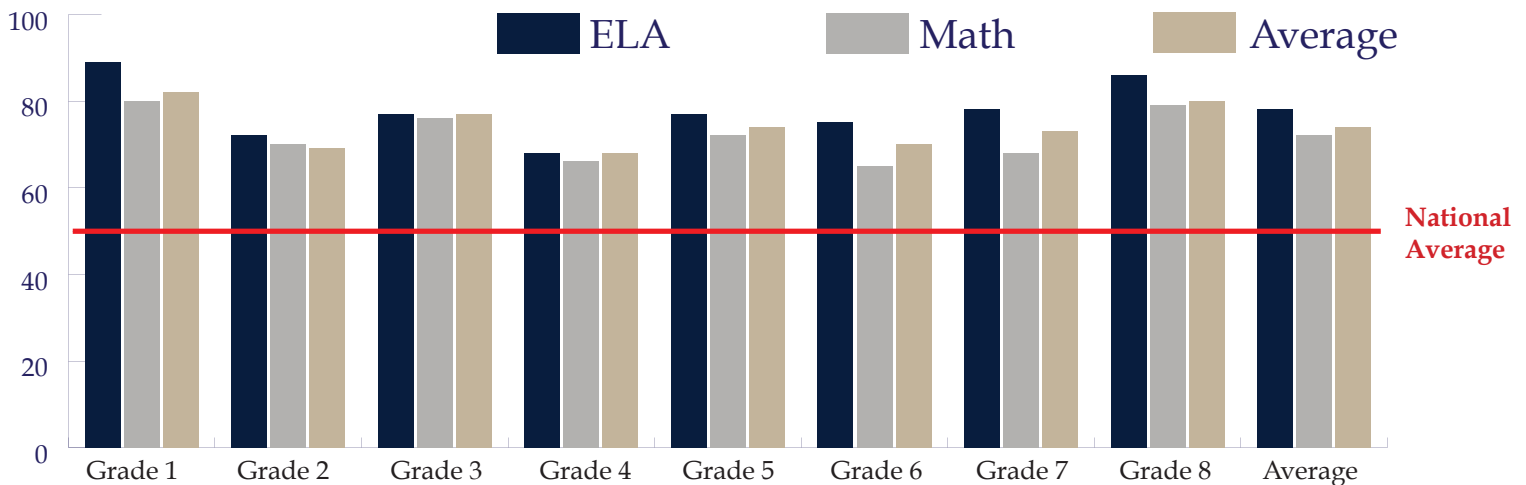

IOWA Assessment Performance

All Saints Catholic School students consistently demonstrate great success on the Iowa Assessments™ by national performance standards. These assessments provide valuable information for parents, teachers, and administrators to ensure student achievement.



The English language arts (ELA) core section of the Iowa Assessments tests reading and conventions of standard written English. All Saints Catholic School student averages for 2015 meets the 78th percentile mark for English language arts for students grades 1-8 (top 22% nationally).

The Mathematics core section of the Iowa Assessments tests various areas of mathematics determined by the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics. All Saints Catholic School student averages for 2015 meets the 72nd percentile mark for mathematics for students grades 1-8 (top 28% nationally).
